

BYLAWS PRIVILEGES AND OBLIGIONS OF MEMBERS

ARTICLE I: VOTING

Only members in good standing shall be entitled to vote on amendments to the Constitution and/or Bylaws and to vote in elections.

ARTICLE II: EXHIBITING

A. Only Members in good standing shall be entitled to exhibit in Guild sponsored shows.

B. To exhibit an artist must be a Guild member in good standing and have attended 2 meetings in the 12 months prior to the exhibition registration date.

C. It shall be the primary responsibility of members exhibiting to safeguard and to promote the interest of the Guild and its members. The Exhibit Committee may reject any piece of art it deems inappropriate or in bad taste for the Guild's exhibit.

D. Works submitted for a judge exhibition must be entirely the work of the artist; completed during the previous twenty-four (24) months and not previously shown in any Guild sponsored exhibition.

Artwork that copies photographs from newspapers, magazines or other publication, or copies another artist's work will not be accepted for any judged Guild exhibition. Printed copies of original works will not be accepted. Paintings which are painted in workshops and classes may be used only if they are the original creative works of the student.
